We have reached an unprecedented high- over 4,000 individuals on ADAP Waiting lists!
How will Congress and the Administration stop this growth?
The waiting list continues to increase as Congress prepares for Winter Recess.

4,109 total individuals in 9 states

Florida: 2,246 individuals
Georgia: 751 individuals
