We have reached an unprecedented high- over 4,000 individuals on ADAP Waiting lists!

How will Congress and the Administration stop this growth?

The waiting list continues to increase as Congress is on leave for elections.

The most up to date situation is*:

4,157 total individuals in 9 states

Florida: 2,306 individuals
Georgia: 676 individuals
Iowa: 29 individuals

Louisiana: 550 individuals
Montana: 10 individuals
North Carolina: 59 individuals

Ohio: 303 individuals
Rhode Island: 7 individuals
South Carolina: 217 individuals
