We have reached an unprecedented high- over 3,000 individuals on ADAP Waiting lists!  
How will Congress and the Administration stop this growth?  
The waiting continues to increase as Congress prepares for election season.

#### The most up to date situation is\*: **3,586 total individuals in 8 states**

Florida: 2,015 individuals  
Georgia: 604 individuals  
Iowa: 13 individuals

Louisiana: 471 individuals  
Montana: 10 individuals  
North Carolina: 44 individuals

Ohio: 258 individuals  
South Carolina: 171 individuals
