We have reached an unprecedented high- over 3,000 individuals on ADAP Waiting lists!  
How will Congress and the Administration stop this growth?  
The waiting list has increased 1000% since May, 2009.

#### The most up to date situation is\*: **3,214 total individuals in 9 states**

Florida: 1,712 individuals  
Georgia: 533 individuals  
Iowa: 0 individuals (program capped)  
Kentucky: 227 individuals  
Louisiana: 394 individuals

Montana: 10 individuals  
North Carolina: 30 individuals  
Ohio: 205 individuals  
South Carolina: 103 individuals
