1996

Since 1996, CANN has convened NAWG as a working group for policy professionals, advocates, and providers operating in this space.

NAWG focuses on the federal and state programs that determine HIV/AIDS treatment access in the United States — the AIDS Drug Assistance Program, Ryan White Care Act implementation, ADAP formularies, and the Medicaid and 340B touchpoints that surround them.

THEN

For nearly three decades, NAWG operated as a paid-membership coalition with Gold, Silver, and Bronze tiers funding the work.

NOW

Open access. No fees, no tiers, no qualification process. Open to anyone working on or affected by these policy questions.

Policy intelligence

Timely updates on what's moving in Washington and in state capitals — bills, regulatory action, executive movement — delivered through the NAWG newsletter and periodic policy calls.

Curated news

A monthly digest of the most relevant HIV/AIDS coverage from across the field, including HIV/HCV co-infection developments and federal program updates.

Network & convening

Periodic calls bringing together AIDS service organizations, ADAP administrators, patient advocacy groups, and HIV/AIDS coalitions working on the same problems.

The convening

NAWG's convening calls bring together the people implementing ADAP, administering Ryan White services, and shaping HIV/AIDS policy. The point isn't networking for its own sake — it's making sure people working on the same problems aren't working in isolation.

- Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program reauthorization
- ADAP rebate revenue impacts from state drug-pricing actions
- Medicaid–ADAP coordination and coverage gaps
- HHS Ending the HIV Epidemic implementation
